We are adding quite a few things to Money Management this week. We have a whole new map and there will be lots of properties up for sale this week. Math 4 - Lessons 49 and 50, Investigation #5. I will also be introducing a new multiplication "incentive" project called Multiplication Banana Split. Starting next week we will be focusing on one set of multiplication facts a week and testing on Thursdays. They will slowly (or quickly) earn their banana split.

Science - Chapter 5 (A Healthy Heart). We will be on this chapter until the end of January. I am looking at a test somewhere around the 25th. We will also be completing our classroom ecosystems this week. Next week we will be starting to talk about Science Fair Projects which will be due in February.

Christmas - Thank you Jacque, Heather, and Ashley for organizing the classroom Christmas party and to all the moms who came and helped. Also, thank you for the class gift; it was very kind of you.

Mr. Raj – Grades 5 & 6 January 4 - January 7

We are back!

We will overall focus on reviewing and getting back into the routine of being back in school

Science. We are continuing onto Chapter 1. Focusing on note-taking strategies as we work through this lesson.

Bible: We will be shifting into a new lesson series called The Stories. Where students will take time today to pick stories from the Bible that they would like to explore.

Math: Green Book: We'll first take time to review concepts of Chapter 3 before we move into L3.5Blue Book: We will also be taking time to review concepts of earlier part of Ch. 4, before

continuing onwards. For both math groups we will be focused on getting back into the swing of math and reviewing.

ELA: We will be working on reading comprehension practice this week.

Vocabulary: No new vocabulary this week, we will be working towards the UBER test on January 13th.

Social Studies: We are starting a new colony this week. Look for more details to come.

Mrs. Lauderdale – Grades 7 & 8 January 4 - January 7

ELA: It is time for Participial phrases this week. Please help your students by reviewing the material with them at home as well. Unit 10 vocabulary, spelling sentences due Wednesday, test on Friday. Roots: plur, multi/poly, mega. Words: pluripotent, pluralize, pluribus, polysyllabic, multitudinous, polynomial, multidimensional, megalomania, megalith, acromegaly. UBER test will be on Friday, January 13th!

AR: As a reminder, reading is 20% of the English grade. Students have until January 14th to meet or exceed their AR goal.

Social Studies: We will be studying the reconstruction era in the post-civil war time frame. Students will be reading Chapter 18 in the text book and completing the Lesson Reviews.

Science: We are moving onto Chapter 12. This chapter has a handful of complicated concepts. We'll focus on habits, tricks, strategies of notetaking, studying, reviewing, to best understand the information and any concepts.

Bible: We will review, and complete 2nd Corinthians promptly this week and move into our next letter, Galatians. When we complete our study of Galatians, we will begin practice writing our own letter in the style of Paul.
