
Hot Lunch Cooks/Assistants Needed!

Spelling Sentences Due on Friday. If a student has a planned Friday absence, they will take their spelling test on Thursday.

Handwriting - Lesson 17 (Border sheets are due on Friday. If you are absent, please make sure they are still turned in).

Math 4 - Math Test #9 will be on Monday. This week students will be working on Lessons 56-59. We will be practicing our 4's in multiplication this week.

Literature - We are currently reading a new book called "A Family Apart." It is based on the true events of the Orphan Trains that traveled west in the late 1800's. We will be reading this book until the end of January.

Science - Today students are coming home with a Science Fair Information Sheet. Please make sure they return to school on Tuesday. There will be a test over Chapter 5 on January 25th.

Field Trip - I have tentatively scheduled a field trip to the California History Museum in Sacramento. This is based of course on COVID restrictions as the date gets closer. The date is March 16. We would leave the school about 8:30 a.m.

Mr. Raj – Grades 5 & 6 January 24 - January 28

Science Fair: student should have a good grasp of their project so much so that they can start running their experiments/tests

Social Studies: We are learning about the Middle Colonies and will have class activities and sheets to support that.

Mrs. Lauderdale – Grades 7 & 8 January 24 - January 28

Bible: having finished the study of Galatians students will begin writing their own letter to one of the churches. Integrating their studying.

ELA: Unit 12 starts this week for vocabulary. Word lists are on Google Classroom. We will also be working on some grammar this week with appositive phrases and independent clauses. There will be 2 small quizzes to go with each lesson.

AR: Congratulations to all those who met their AR goal last quarter. We will provide lunch on Thursday as a celebration of their hard work.

Social Studies: We are continuing Chapter 19 and will do lessons 3 & 4 this week with review questions due Tuesday & Thursday. Students will continue to take notes and prepare for the essay test for Chapter 18 & 19 on February 3.

Science: While focusing on science fair our time in-class will be split with working on science fair and Chapter 12
