Please make an extra effort to be sure your child is well rested and well fed during testing week. Thank you.



#### Mr. Selby – Grades 3 February 7 - February 11

Spelling (Lesson 20) - Words - average, jacket, merge, cringe, jury, manage, heritage, badge, junior, legend, jaguar, dungeon, jogging, gadget, hinges, rigid, justice, plunge, refuge, pledge. \*For the next two weeks I will not be requiring students to write spelling sentences. I would like them to focus on their science projects. We will still have a test on Friday.

**Handwriting** - Lesson 18 (Border sheets are due on Friday. If you are absent, please make sure they are still turned in).

**Math 4** - This week we will be working on L62-64. We will continue working on our 4's this week. Many students are needing to study them a bit more.

**Science** - I hope all science fair projects are going well. Remember that all projects and papers need to be at school by Friday. Judges will be at the school Sunday morning, so we need everything ready by Friday.

MAP Testing - We will continue with our testing this week. We completed the Math and Science Tests last week. I was very happy to see a good jump in their math scores. This week we will be doing our Reading and Language Usage Tests. There are also quite a few kids who need to do some make-up tests.

Valentine's Day - I always like to do something with the kids on Valentine's Day. We will decorate some bags this week and on Monday, the 14th they can pass out Valentines to their classmates. Of course this is not required, but it is fun. My standard rule is that if you bring a Valentine for one, you need to bring one for all the kids. I will send a list of names home on Friday.

**Field Trip** - I have tentatively scheduled a field trip to the California History Museum in Sacramento. This is based of course on COVID restrictions as the date gets closer. The date is March 16. We would leave the school about 8:30 a.m.
