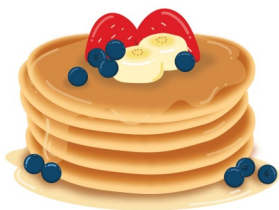


8th Grade Hot Lunch Fund-raiser

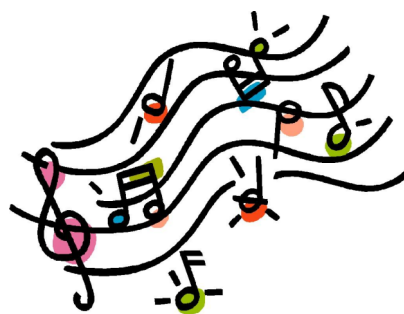
Come Learn About Our Wonderful Kindergarten Program!
