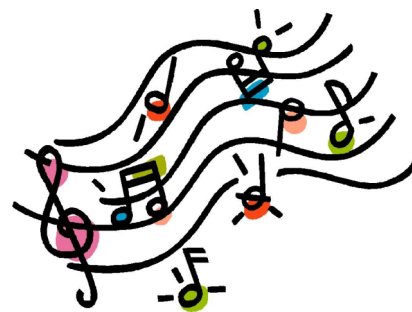


Spring Break is on the Way!
