To be at grade level a student needs to perform at the 50th percentile; anything above 50 is considered above grade level.

Our school is well above the national average, and we are so proud of all the improvement that so many of our students have made. I am also so thankful for such a dedicated group of teachers who work so diligently to do their best to meet the needs of our students. During our staff meetings, we not only plan together, but we help each other with ideas to improve our academics, reach students who are struggling, and provide additional academics for those students who are ready for more challenges.
