## Mrs. Bartsch - Grades 3 & 4

**\*This is obviously a very long memory verse so we are giving the kids two weeks to memorize it. They will recite the verse from memory on Friday, September 16th. We will go over the first section in class this week and then the other half next week. I have put in bold the section we will be working on this week.**

## SPELLING - Lesson 3

**Level C** - whale, Thursday, chair, wheat, whip, thirteen, change, cheek, cheese, cherry, shock, bother, north, thankful, whether

**Level D** - against, pleasant, leather, yesterday, breakfast, meant, dead, ahead, sweat, instead, lead, measure, wealth, built, comfort, couple, cousin, trouble

**Level E** - income, England, insist, Virginia, glitter, disk, glisten, Mississippi, Michigan, lizard, limit, assist, index, discuss, hymn, admit, infant, history, cliffs, kidnap

Spelling sentences will be due on Friday. Sentences must be written in **complete sentences**,

using **correct spelling, capitalization, punctuation**, etc. The spelling word that is used in the sentence needs to be underlined and a minimum of **8** words need to be in the sentence.

**Yellow Book** - Chapter 1 Practice, Chapter 1 Test Thursday.

**Orange Book** - 2.1 - 2.2

**Science** - Chapter 7, Lesson 2. Review for quiz over Lesson 2. **We have rescheduled the quiz from Tuesday to Thursday.** The quiz will be a 5 point quiz covering the material in Lesson 2. Students are coming home today with a copy of that lesson to review. On Thursday we will begin to go over Lesson 3.

**Social Studies** - Chapter 1, Lesson 3. We will begin learning about the different regions (coast, valley, desert, mountain) in California. Students will have a California Geography Paper that will come home on Mondays and will be due on Friday. They will need to go online to find some of the answers. We will remind them to always ask their parents before they get on their computers. They will have a new lesson every week for the next nine weeks.

**Handwriting** - Lesson 4

**Music** - We have a ukulele teacher for 3rd and 4th graders. Her name is Mandalyn McClelland. She has many years of experience teaching both private and group lessons. She works with Music Connection here in Chico and has worked with many schools in the area. She will be starting on September 7th. A school ukulele will be checked out to them and they will be responsible for making sure it is brought to school on Mondays and Wednesdays.

## **Mr. Raj – Grades 5 & 6**

### **September 6 - September 9**

**Science:** We will begin covering concepts from Ch. 11.2. It is important that students are taking notes during class to practice note-taking skills (notes are collected at the time of the test, will periodically be checked)

**Bible:** This will be our last week on the concept of Salvation.

Memory Verse: *But Jesus said, 'Now, go home to your friends, and tell them what wonderful things the Lord has done for you and how merciful he has been' Mark 5:19*

### **Math**

**Green Book:** Chapter 1 test set for Wednesday 7th

**Red Workbook:** 1.7 and Chapter 1 Test on Friday

**ELA:** Unit 3 of Vocabulary this week, test on Friday. Students need to know the spelling, definition, root, & meaning for the tests. They have a 'packet' for vocabulary each week. For the first quarter, we will work on finishing that packet together. They will work on that independently starting 2nd Quarter. We started our diary last week. We are continuing to read Al Capone Does My Shirts.

**AR:** Just a reminder that AR is 20% of their ELA grade. Please encourage them to get started reading early and to read often!

**Social Studies:** Chapter 2 is all about geography! We will be studying the 5 themes of geography this week and learning about Economy.

## **Mrs. Lauderdale – Grades 7 & 8**

### **September 6 - September 9**

**Wagon Trip:** We leave this weekend! We will be leaving on September 11 (Sunday) and returning on September 16 (Friday). For those students not attending the field trip, an assignment will post to Google Classroom on Monday September 12 and will be due on Friday September 16. No late assignments will be accepted.

**Wagon Trip Prep Thursday 9/8:** We will head up to PAE on Thursday this week to visit with the 7th & 8th grade class there and get a preview of the tents and other wagon trip gear. We will leave at 12:30 and return by 3:10pm. Permission slips went home TODAY

**Bible:** Continue our studying of Mark. Though notes aren't required it is highly encouraged so that students are staying engaged with the material.

**AR:** AR goals have been set. They are based on 20 minutes of reading every night. Please encourage your child to read.

**Social Studies:** Chapter 16 Lessons 1 & 2 The Americas. Students will be reading a variety of articles to support the chapter in the book End of Quarter test will be on Thursday October 20, covering chapters 14, 16, & 17

**Science:** Though we've been falling behind, we will take time this week to get back on track through Chapter 8.
