## Mrs. Miceli - Grades 1 & 2 September 19 - September 23

**Memory Verse:** "Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Do not be dismayed, for I am your God." Isaiah 41:10 (first part) This will be a two week memory verse.

**Spelling, Grade 1:** an, at, cat, ran, man, ran, dad, thank, add, ask \*We will have the test on Friday.

**Spelling, Grade 2:** nest, help, leg, next, set, best, ever, left, men, head, again, sentence, never \*We will have the test on Friday.

**MAP Testing:** This week we will begin our testing. First graders will take Reading and Math tests. Second graders will take Reading, Math and Language tests. We have headphones at school, but if your child would like their own headphones, they may bring them to school.

**"All About Me" Posters:** This Friday, Macey and Brooklyn will share their posters. Next week will be Gabbie and Jackson.

**Raz-Kids/Reading A-Z:** Instead of specific books assigned to your student, I would like them to pick at least 2 or more books (along with the quizzes) from their assigned level per week (their choices). This will be part of their reading grade. It may count towards the weekly reading requirement - 10 minutes 4x weekly for first graders/ 15-20 minutes 4x weekly for second graders.
