# Homework & Class Information---

## Music

February 6 - February 10

### Ms. May - Grades 3 & 4

Beginners are being quizzed on their C scale exercises this week. We will work on completing Rocky Mountain, continue work on our arpeggios, hammer-ons and pull-offs for Wiegenlied, and continue to practice our chords and chord songs. Please encourage your students to practice! Music homework is still homework! Thank you!

Intermediate students are working on their group duet of Wiegenleid, and perfecting their hammer-ons and pull-offs for that one super tricky section towards the end. We have also begun work singing Au Clair de la Luna while playing a harmony part, and then switching parts - playing the melody while singing the harmony. This is an exercise to improve both their vocal harmony and ear training. This is definitely a challenge, and the student needs to have already mastered singing each part while playing the same part in order to attempt the duet at the same time. (So, if they are having trouble with the most challenging part of the assignment, feel free to redirect them to playing and singing one part at a time before they make their next attempt.)

One of the most important aspects of ear training is simply learning to listen to more than one part at once, and this exercise is one of their first attempts. I don't expect all students to be able to accomplish it fully, but I do expect all of them to try. :-)
