Intermediate students have started Long, Long Ago and should be playing it in both positions to maintain their comprehension of their C and F scales in both first and second position. We will be transposing Au Clair de la Luna this week during class, by moving their second position scales up and down the neck. They are also working on practicing their Bb chord, which takes more finger strength than the chords they have played so far. Songs that use this chord are coming up in March.
