# **Homework & Class Information---**

Music March 20 - March 24

Ms. May - Grades 3 & 4

Beginners are being quizzed on Part 1 of Au Clair de La Luna, and will continue working on Part 2. As we learn Part 2 we will also begin to learn the F scale up the neck. Students should begin to practice their F scale in both positions in order to solidify their reading and muscle memory. For chord songs, they have started on One Day, which requires switching between chords faster than they have done so far. Keep up the good work!

Intermediate Students will continue to do speed trials on Long, Long Ago Variation, and are working on learning Malie's Song. We will be learning this song in a chord-melody arrangement this week. Students will practice playing the chord at the beginning of the measure, and then picking the remaining notes. This is a relatively advanced skill, requiring concentration, dexterity, and timing of chords while reading and analyzing the melody notes. I expect it will go slowly in the beginning. Students are encouraged to listen to the original by Keali'i Reichel for a good example of the correct pronunciation.

They are also working on learning How Great Thou Art, How Far I'll Go, One Day, and I will add an additional hymn by the end of the week. I just discovered that Morning Has Broken is a hymn written in 1931 to a Scottish tune from 1888, so it may be that one:)
