# Homework & Class Information---

Music Ms. May - Grades 3 & 4 May 1 - May 5

Beginner students are working on learning/ playing both parts of Au Clair de la Lune. Last week's quiz determined that most can play the Uke 1 part, but not the entire Uke 2 part. The goal for our spring performance is to be able to play and sing both parts, as a duet with the intermediate group. This can only happen with practice, and so far this group has been challenged in that area. Please reinforce with your students that practice is necessary, especially with the performance coming up!

Intermediate students are working to integrate both the chords and melody notes into their performance of Malie's song. They have been doing a great job so far with the notes and chords individually. This song also incorporates use of their first bar chord, and it takes time to develop the muscle strength to play it well. If they are experiencing difficulty with this chord, I have encouraged them to work on their Bb exercises, that are intended to help them strengthen their finger position while also playing individual notes to determine whether or not each string has been pressed down correctly.

They are also continuing to practice their harmonies for Au Clair de la Lune, in preparation for a duet with the beginner class, and working on adding sparkle notes or riffs to How Far I'll Go.
