#### Music

Ms. May - Grades 1st - 4th January 3 - January 5

**Happy 2024!** I hope all of you had a wonderful and festive Christmas break. I also hope many of you got to sing with your kids and let them show you the Christmas songs they learned before the holidays.

This first Wednesday back is a check in to see where we are, and what skills we might need to review before we can tackle new material.

Beginning Music and Motion: 1st and 2nd Grade We will review our last rhythm exercise and see if we are ready to begin a new one. We will also be learning some new motions that cross the midline - always a plus for developing brains!

<u>Ukulele 1 (Beginners): 3rd and 4th grade</u> Uke 1 students were given a repertoire review sheet to work on during the Christmas Break.
