I anticipate adjustments will need to be made, but for now:

Your child will need access to a device with a camera and microphone. Good news –

Log into Google Classroom before Wednesday morning. You will need your child's Chico Oaks email, password, and our classroom code. Please check your email for that information.

Our first live session will be Wednesday at 10:30. I'd like to practice with students beforehand. I'll contact you tomorrow and arrange a time.

Going forward, the plan is to hold live sessions on Google Meet from 10:30-11:00 M-Th. Friday sessions TBD.

My **office hours** will be M-Th 9-2 with a lunch break from 11:30-noon. I plan to be in the classroom working and available

online to answer questions live, chat, or respond to texts and emails.

Miss Yin – Grades 3 & 4 April 1 – April 3

Hello,

I hope you all had a good Spring Break! Here are some announcements for the week:

Distance learning: As we embark on our distance learning journey, I would like students to understand that, school will continue despite the circumstances and that they are responsible for getting work done. Attendance will also be taken. Students will be required to check-in with me every school day to make sure they are getting work done. We will be using Google Meet for these check-ins. I will be announcing the times and instructions for how to use Google Meet. You can either download the app on your devices or use a computer with a camera. I will also be uploading weekly lessons for Handwriting, Spelling, Phonics, and 3rd Grade Math on YouTube and will be sharing the links.

Weekly Lesson Plan Guides will also be sent to use as a guideline on what needs to be completed by the end of the week. These guides have checkboxes to check off assignments as students complete them. Students will need to either pick up these guides at school every week or print them out and complete the form. I inserted links on the guide which include links to videos, files, or assignments. They can be accessed when viewing the guide on your device (phone, tablet, computer, etc.). This form will be due at the end of the week along with

their assignments, signed by student and parent/guardian. You can turn in assignments using Google Classroom or inperson in our assigned class turn-in box in the school's library.

Google Classroom: I am very happy that all the class joined our Google Classroom. We will be using it a lot to access certain online forms and even use it as a turn-in box. You can either download the app on your tablet or phone or use the online (computer) version to upload assignments. Pictures of assignments are acceptable or pdf. If you still need any help, please let me know. Another option is to turn in assignments inperson in our assigned class turn-in box.

Textbooks: I will do my best to update the class website with access to assignments to print. However, I would strongly suggest students use their actual workbooks and textbooks to save ink and paper. Several parents came by the school before spring break and picked up all of their child's workbooks and textbooks. I would like to advise you to come by the classroom if you haven't already and pick up all the workbooks & textbooks. You will be using them a lot! Please come by at the beginning of this week to be ready for the school week.

Issues you might encounter: If you do not have a printer, you can come by at the beginning of each week and pick up a packet of printed additional forms like tests or important worksheets, such as weekly agenda.

If you do not have a computer, you can check out a Chromebook from the classroom on Monday 3/30 & 3/31. Parents will need to sign a Release of Liability form to check one out. One laptop per household.

If you do not have internet, Spectrum is providing free internet access. The number to call is 1 (800) 488-8398.

Office hours: Each day Ms. Logan will be holding "office hours" on Google meets. This will occur every school day from 1:00 - 3:30 PM where students can drop in and informally ask questions related to the designated homework subject. Each student is required to appear for at least 10 minutes of office hours twice a week.

Weekly Assignments:

In our new Google classroom setup, each week's work will be posted at the beginning of the week, Wednesday in this case, with specific due dates. These can also be picked up from the school in physical copy at your convenience. There is a box in the library with "Work Packets" for students who prefer to work with physical copy. Due to the shortness of the week, we will not be having handwriting or vocabulary.

Communication: Students are encouraged to ask questions in "comment" sections under each assignment or send me direct emails to klogan@chicooaks.org though students should be advised that most responses will occur from 8:00a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

I miss all the sixth graders very much and honestly **CANNOT WAIT** to see all their faces on Wednesday morning Google meets!

Miss Logan -

This is your week at a glance schedule. Every morning from 8:30 - 9:00 we will have an optional guided worship time in our Google Meet. Afterwards I have two hours set aside for pre arranged meetings. I ask that all requests for individual meetings be made before 6:00PM the night before but keep in mind it will be on a first come, first serve basis. Each meeting will be kept to ten minutes long unless there have been no other requests. Parent appointments will be from 9:00AM to 10 AM and student appointments will be from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM.

The only <u>REQUIRED</u> time for students to be on the live Google Meet, will be everyday from <u>11:00 - 12:00AM</u>. During this time, attendance will be taken and weekly assignments and lessons will be gone over. If for any reason a student is unable to attend at this particular time, the class will be recorded and the video will be posted. There are also many opportunities to make up their attendance grade by attending one or more of the same-day <u>OPTIONAL</u> guided office hours.

The time between 1:00 and 3:30 have been divided up into half hour periods where students can ask questions about specific subjects. If students have questions that do not fall within the scheduled office hour subjects, they may attend the General Question and Discussion period at the end of the day. Again, the only time students are **REQUIRED** to attend Google Meets live meetings is from 11:00 - 12:00 AM, everything else is optional though encouraged. Students can always email questions they might have on specific questions and I will do my best to answer those questions in a timely manner. During this time of upheaval, we must do our best to be available to help each other while maintaining a high level of patience for human error.
